PENTIMENT - MAIN GALLERY

Pentiment takes its title from the art-historical concept of pentimento, where earlier compositions surface through layers of paint. Traditionally, these traces emerge unintentionally over time. Here, they are constructed deliberately.

This body of work approaches painting not as a fixed image, but as a record of time. Layers are built, buried, and partially revealed. Scratches expose the painting's past, giving equal weight to what is concealed and what remains visible. In the end, a painting's surface is only a single moment.

Human forms lie at the centre of this exploration. Fragmented limbs, torsos, and flesh merge and intertwine until individuality dissolves into human totality. These anonymous figures serve as proxies for our shared, fragile condition: finite and bound to change...





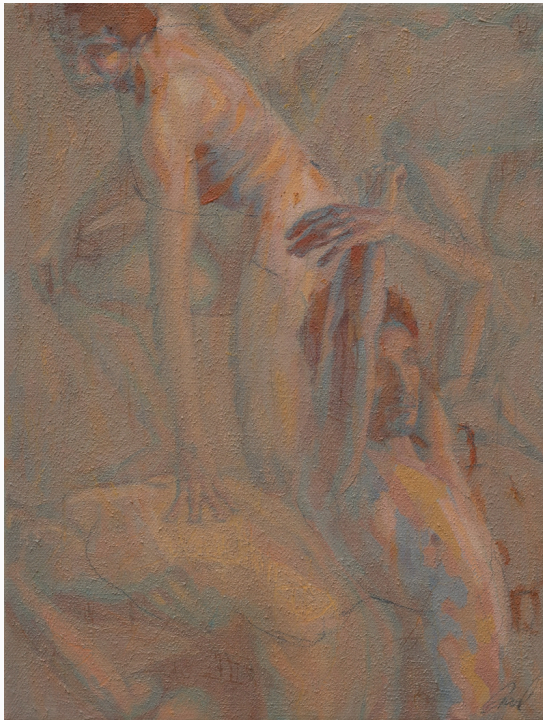

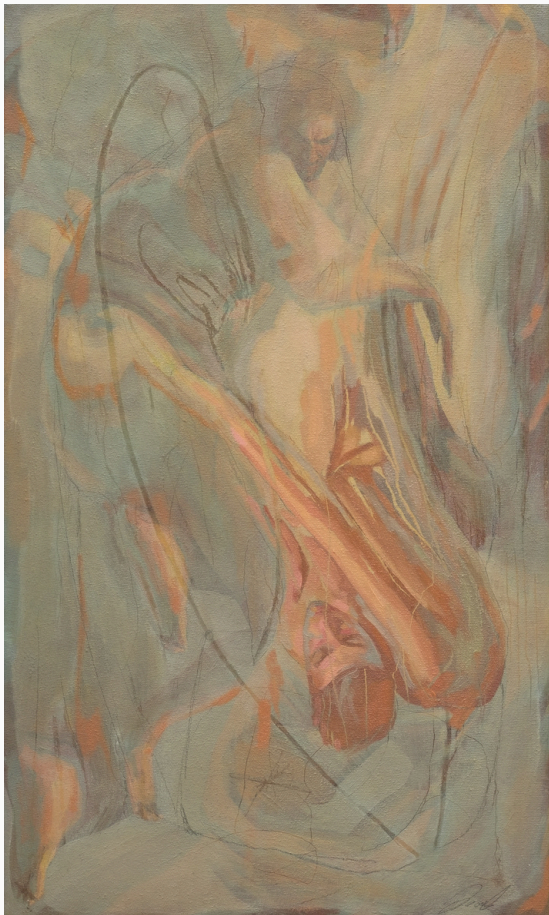

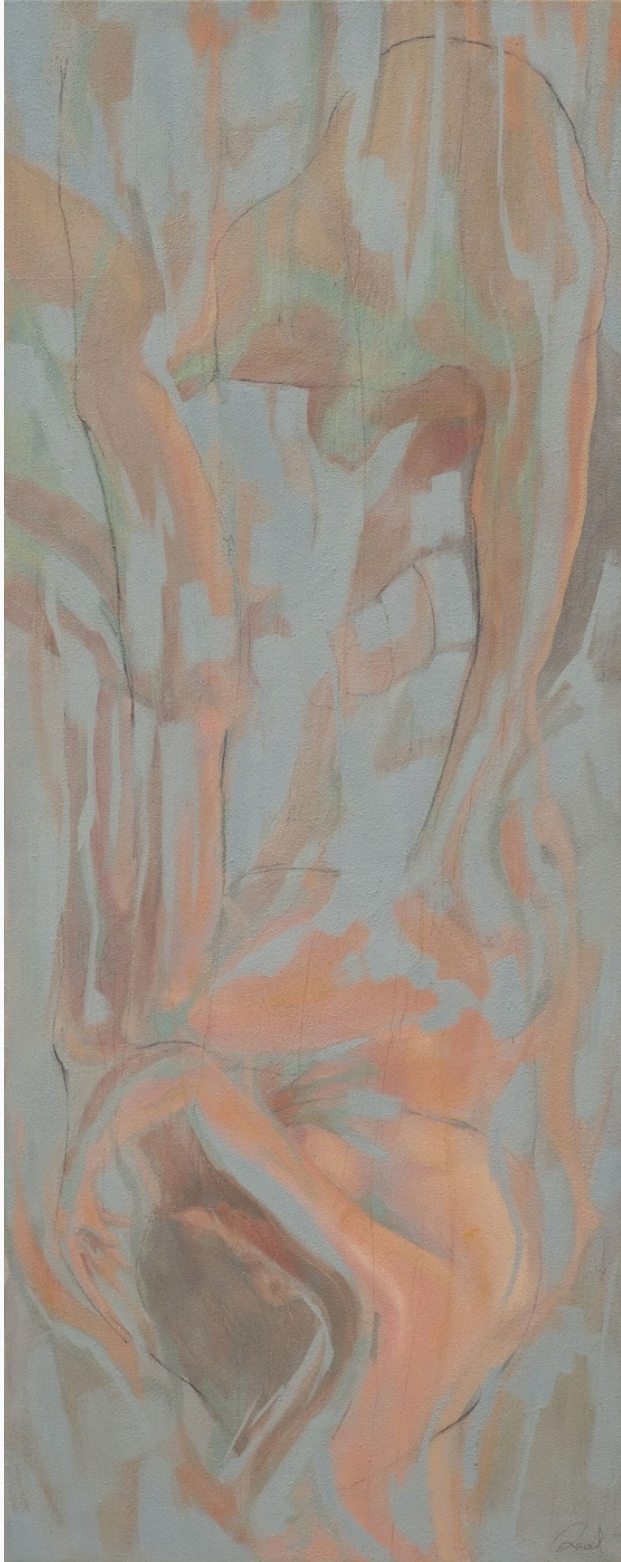

THE PLACES THAT MADE ME



“The Places that Made Me” is an intimate exploration of my relationship to body, environment, self and place. Stemming from the experience growing up in a society that ruthlessly scrutinizes the female body, this collection was inspired by the process of seeking wholeness through seeing myself in relation to the land I love. My paintings explore the wild and twisting forms of nature by exaggerating the patterns and abstractions that characterize this environment as to inspire a sense of curiosity and wonder. The figures and the landscapes in this collection exist independently yet connected, each shaping the other, each serving as a metaphor for the other: how a landscape can bruise as easily as flesh and how a body is only ever growing and changing with the seasons, both so fragile and shockingly resilient. I hope that through my work I can inspire others to connect to their environments with love, wonder and respect.

WILDFIRE

Themes of the natural world are common in my paintings and are usually of the places where my family and I have traveled. I first painted a post-fire landscape several years ago after a canoe trip in Northern Saskatchewan took us through a burned out part of the Churchill River system. In contrast to the heavily blackened forest, the ground was carpeted in Fireweed, a vibrant pink and green show of resurgence and renewal. Since then, I have followed the progress of our fire seasons, spoken to scientists, researched and read, and then painted my versions of what it means to live with fire in our vast and forested country. We all have our own experiences with the wildfires; this is my attempt to capture the feelings of the fires in progress, what it means to fight fire, and how we understand and accept our landscape after the fires are out and the regrowth begins.
